The Okanagan Valley boasts nearly 200 wineries, each uniquely different and all with the same goal: to produce a wine that is reflective of the valley, and as such have now been recognized on the world stage.

We'll swirl and sip our way with Okanagan Wine Country Tours along the West Kelowna Wine Trail visiting some of the most iconic Okanagan Wineries. We'll begin with Sandhill Urban Winery in the heart of Kelowna, then on to the Quails Gate Estate Winery where we'll experience a lovely three-course lunch overlooking the vineyard and lake, and finally on to the famous Mission Hill Family Estate Winery. You'll have a chance to visit gift shops and purchase wines as well. Be sure to leave some room in your suitcase!

The tour includes coach transportation from the hotel, guided tours and tastings at three West Kelowna wineries (Sandhill, Quail's Gate and Mission Hill) and a three-course lunch at Quail's Gate Winery.

#### **ACCOMMODATIONS**

#### **Room Rates**

CCSA has negotiated a block of rooms that have been reserved for Connect 2019 delegates. We **recommend that you book your room at the Delta Grand Okanagan at your earliest convenience**. A <u>limited</u> number of rooms are available for Friday and Saturday nights. Standard guest rooms are offered at a rate of \$259 plus taxes, and a Resort Fee of \$20 per room per night plus taxes. The deluxe room is \$309 plus taxes and resort fee.

#### Reservations

Accommodations can be booked online at <u>Book your group rate for CCSA Connect 2019</u> or by calling the Reservations Department at 1-888-236-2427. Please mention the group code 'Canadian Communication Systems Alliance (CCSA) Connect' or the Mini Hotel Code 'SYA' in order to receive the special rates. The **deadline for receiving the CCSA group rate is Friday, August 16**<sup>th</sup>, pending availability.

#### **Resort Fee**

Please note that when booking online, the Resort Fee will show a \$30 fee; however, CCSA has negotiated this down to \$20 and this will be reflected on your bill upon check-in. The hotel website is not able to reflect this decrease. Complimentary airport shuttle service is included as part of the resort fee. #### Cancellation policy: 72 hours before check-in

If your reservation is cancelled within 3 days of arrival, one night's room and tax will be charged to the credit card used to guarantee this reservation.

#### WHAT TO PACK FOR THE CONFERENCE

The Delta Marriott Resort is located on beautiful Lake Okanagan and includes a walking trail that will take you along the downtown waterfront and Rotary Marsh Bird Sanctuary. Downtown Kelowna, with its shops, restaurants and galleries, is only a few steps away from the hotel. You may want to pack walking shoes.

We recommend business casual for most conference sessions, with the exception of the Tuesday evening event. Based on the positive feedback from last year's casual approach to the Board of Director's Dinner - we're going to keep it that way. Dress comfortably for a relaxed evening (e.g., jeans and casual shirts/blouses and shoes).

**Wine Tour** - Those participating in the Wine Trail Tour can expect warm temperatures in the valley. Please be prepared with comfortable walking shoes and a rain coat (in the event of rain).

**Golfers** - Get ready for beautiful scenery and a challenging game. You may want to bring a camera in addition to your regular golf attire.
